- Control of energy supply and demand



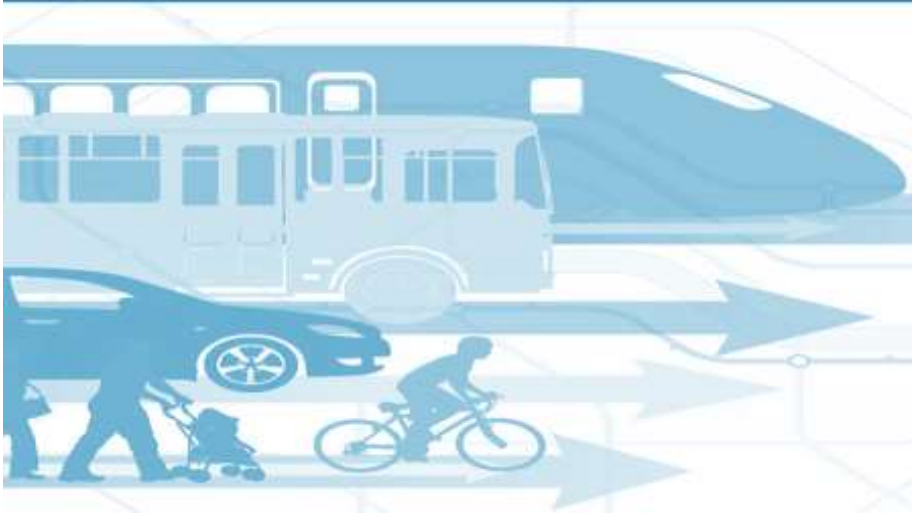
Changing user needs
