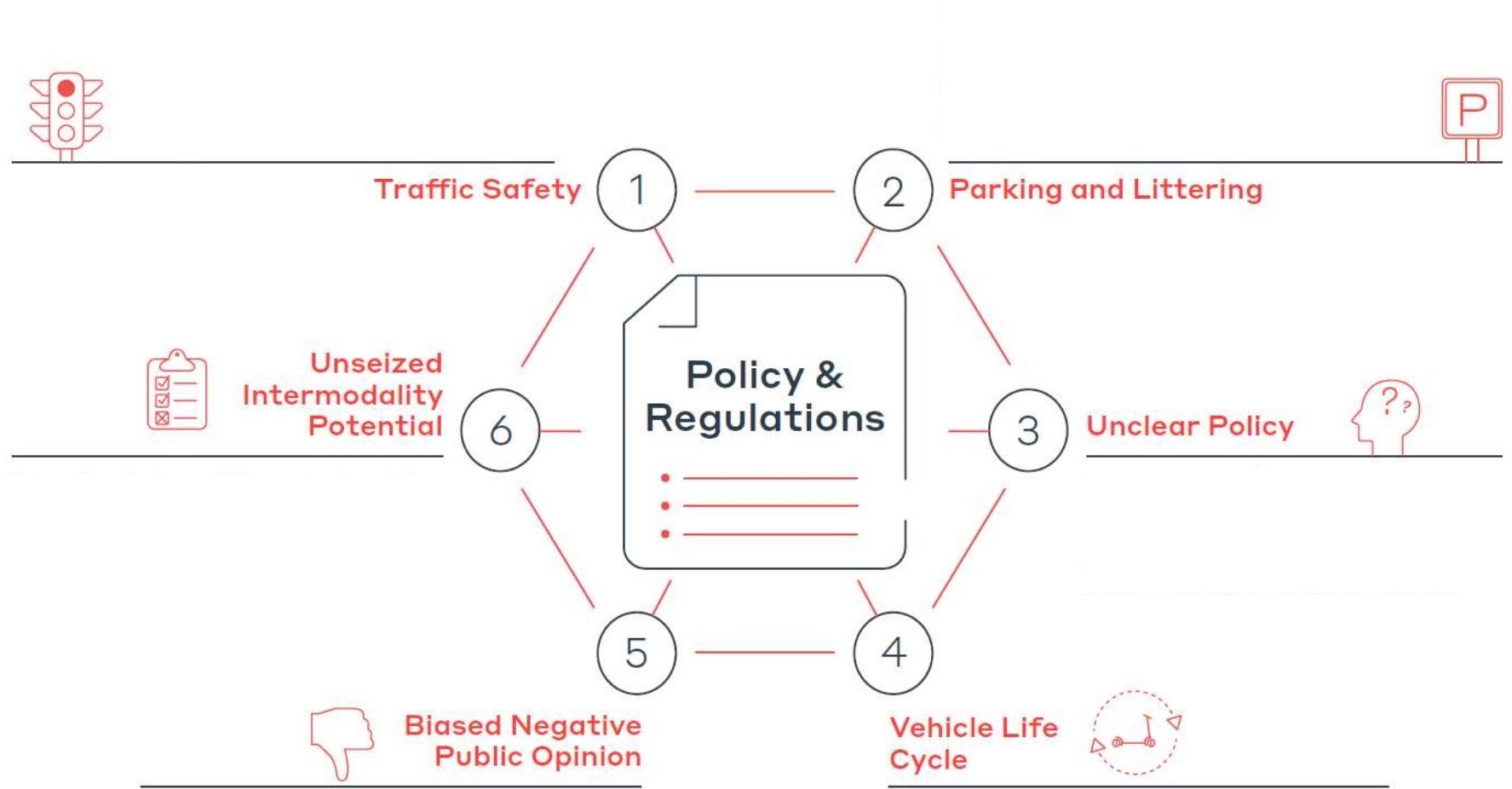

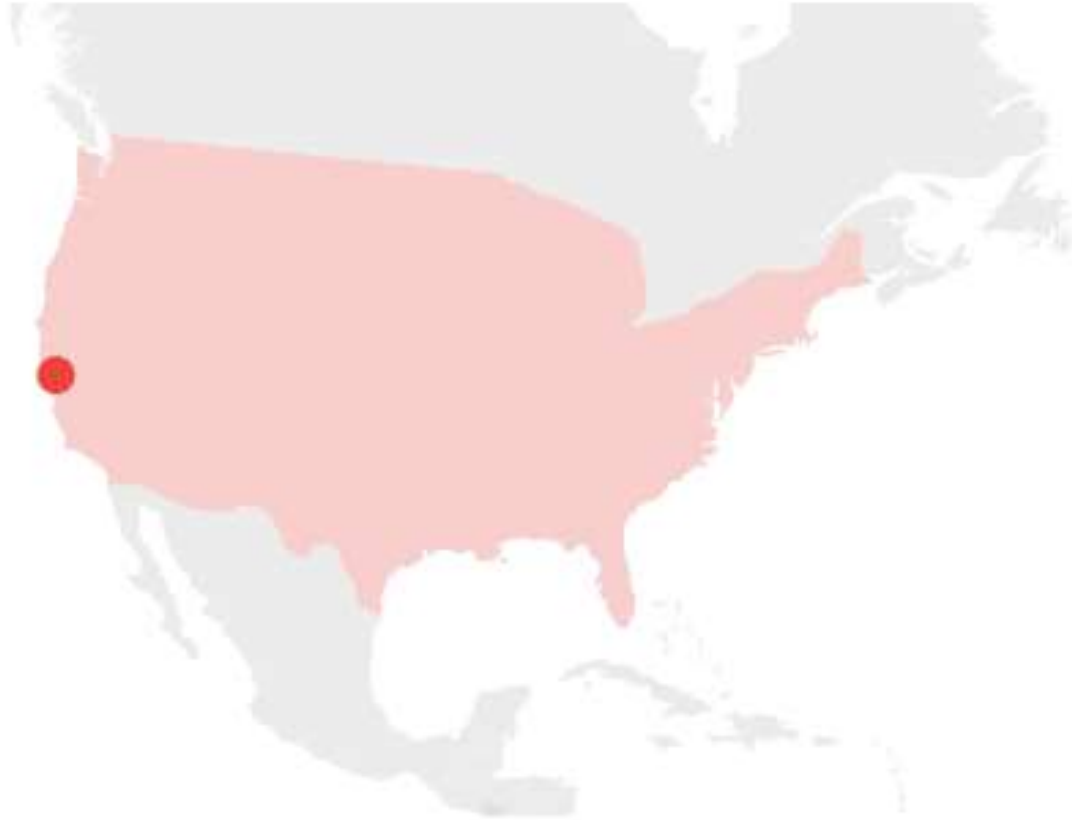

Pandemic spells uncertain future for bikes and scooters as mobility services confront new realities

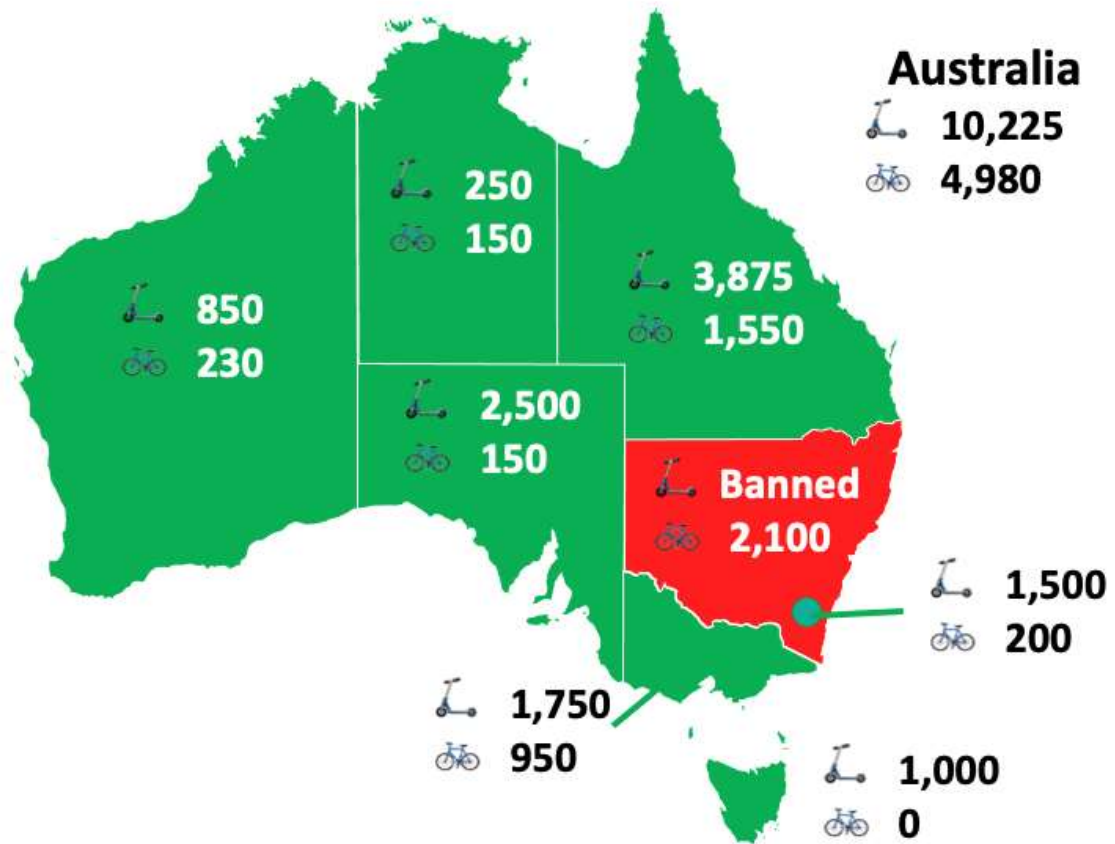
Transportation
